
- 2,100,000 youth participated in 2019

 - Within seven days of the event there will be no refund





Advancement Guidelines – Scouts BSA

New BSA guidance on advancement during COVID-19

This includes:

- Time extensions for qualifying Scouts and Venturers working on the Eagle Scout.
- Local councils have the authority to grant extensions through the end of September 2020.
- The ability to accept electronic signatures for rank advancement and award applications effective through the end of September 2020.
- An option to complete Scoutmaster conferences via videoconferencing.
- An option for Scoutmasters to allow time missed during the COVID-19 outbreak to count toward requirements for participation and positions of responsibility.



Extension for Eagle Boards of Review for the Inaugural Class of Female Eagle Scouts

- The period for boards of review will be extended from 10/1/2020-1/31/2021.
- To further support the Inaugural Class, all boards of review will be dated with the same date by the National Service Center.
- The lengthening of the Eagle board of review window is applicable to all Scouts who were granted the Inaugural extension, regardless of gender.


