





### "The Donut Shop"





# Cub Grub - Edible Play Dough!

(Bears and Webelos can use edible play dough when they do their Art Elective or Artist Activity Badge. It's as fun to eat, as it is to play with.)

#### Den size

1 box yellow or white cake mix 1 cube soft margarine 3 TBS water



#### Individual size

1/2 cup cake mix1 TBS margarine and1/2 tsp water.

- 1. Mix all the ingredients in a large bowl or large ziplock bag
- 2. Remove air from bag and let the cubs take turns squishing it until it is mixed
- 3. After most of the play dough is mixed, the cubs can empty the baggie onto a plate and finish mixing it outside the bag.

## **More Edible Play Dough**

#### **Peanut Butter Play Dough**

1-cup peanut butter1-cup corn syrup or honey1 ¼ cup powdered milk1 ¼ cup powdered sugar



Mix well. If play dough is too sticky, add a bit more powdered milk. Divide into 8 to 10 pieces. Unused play dough can be stored in the refrigerator.

#### **Another Edible Play Dough**

Use any frosting, homemade or store bought. Add powdered sugar until it becomes the right consistency
